
Message from Connie Glover

constant question about my appearance: “What are you?”



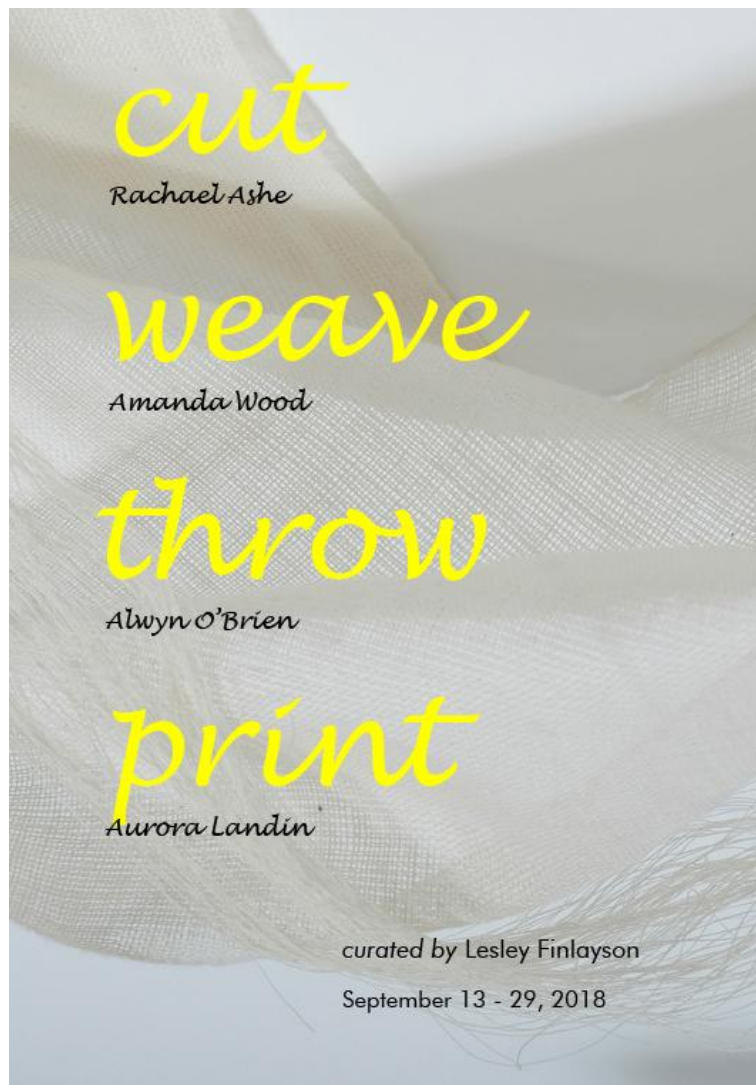
Jennifer Ling Datchuk. *Dark and Lovely*, 2014.
